

# KES UNIFORM REGULATIONS 2023-24

## DRESS AND APPEARANCE

All pupils are expected to maintain a high standard of personal appearance that ensures they represent themselves and the School in the best possible light and is appropriate for a co-ed school with pupils from the age of 3 upwards. The overall principles are formality, tidiness, smartness and lack of ostentation. These principles, and the detailed rules which derive from them, apply when pupils are on the School premises, travelling to and from school, attending examinations or representing the School in any way.

### Years 7-11 – Detailed Uniform Regulations

<b>Blazers</b>	Navy blue School blazer.
<b>Blouses, Shirts and Ties</b>	Plain, formal white blouse/shirt with collar to be worn. Short-sleeved shirts are permitted. Boys are required to wear a school tie. Girls may wear a tie with an appropriate shirt, should they wish to do so.
<b>Pullovers</b>	V-necked, navy blue official School pullovers with Tudor rose.
<b>Footwear</b>	Shoes are to be worn which are formal in nature, black and polished. Socks/Tights to be plain and dark.
<b>Kilts and Trousers</b>	Skirts: Lower/Middle School Tartan kilts to be worn in Years 7 to 9. Upper School skirts in blue tartan to be worn in Years 10 and 11. Skirts should be on the knee. Trousers: Formal, plain grey trousers

## GENERAL RULES (ALL PUPILS)

General Rules (All Pupils)	
<b>Bags</b>	Pupils are expected to carry School books in suitable bags, capable of fitting into lockers (Years 7-11), where they should be stored during the school day. Games and CCF kit should be carried in a separate bag.
<b>Coats</b>	Outdoor coats should be smart, long enough to cover a pupil's blazer and be of a sober single colour, e.g. a smart anorak, outdoor jacket or overcoat in black, brown or blue. They must not have patterns, logos or other embroidery.
<b>Hair</b>	Hair is to be clean, tidy and of a natural colour. As a general guide, all hairstyles should be of a grade 2 or above.  Facial hair (stubble, beards, moustaches, excessively long sideburns) is not permitted unless permission has been granted by the Deputy Head (Pastoral) for religious reasons.
<b>Jewellery</b>	All jewellery must be small and discreet.
<b>Cosmetics</b>	Discreet make-up and nail varnish are permitted.

The school acknowledges that parents may from time to time request variations to the school's dress code due to religion or belief, race, disability or on medical grounds. Any such request will always be given careful consideration on a case by case basis.

The Heads of Sector, in consultation with the Deputy Head (Pastoral) will be the final arbiter on whether a garment does or does not conform to the uniform regulations, and pupils or parents who are in doubt are advised to check on its suitability before being worn to school.
